

# ST. GERARD CAPITAL CAMPAIGN:

The Scope of the Project: Our parish is proposing a 3-part building proposal to better serve the needs of our parish and local community and to strengthen our long-term financial viability. This proposal is estimated at \$2.4 million. We are asking our parishioners and friends of St. Gerard to donate a total of \$1.3 million. Our projects are:

1. Church Gathering Space: Our church needs a gathering space. The gathering space will be used for after weekend Masses, baptisms, anniversaries, funeral viewings, and meeting space (i.e. prayer/study groups, RCIA). We propose to seal off our front doors and level out the partitioned walls and floor to create a sizable gathering space including a new handicap-accessible bathroom.



- 2. Parish Office Relocation: The current parish office location is inadequate and difficult for our aging and handicap parishioners (i.e. over a 100 yard walk from the church parking lot). We propose to relocate the parish office to our under-utilized parish hall entrance and small meeting room. This would allow for handicap and general parking in a close vicinity to better serve our parishioners.
- **3. Eight Additional Classrooms:** St. Gerard School is in need of more classrooms. We propose to add eight additional classrooms and two bathrooms onto our new school building. St. Gerard Parish has looked at options of renovating our old school building. Estimated renovation costs are \$3.6 million which is financially out of reach for our parish (and this cost doesn't even include the six basement classrooms).

To help us reach our goal, we are asking every family to participate. Every gift, no matter how large or small, is appreciated. # BISHOP DANIEL THOMAS VISITS WITH FAMILIES OF DETAINEES AFTER THE ICE RAID IN SANDUSKY:

On Sunday, June 17, Bishop Daniel E. Thomas celebrated the regularly scheduled 1:30 p.m. Sunday Mass in Spanish for the Hispanic community at Saint Paul Church in Norwalk. He went to be pastorally present with them, to pray with them and to visit with them. The congregation included numerous families whose spouses, parents, children, brothers and sisters are now detained following the recent ICE raid in Sandusky at Corso's Flower and Garden Centers.

In meeting with the families affected by this radical action, Bishop Thomas heard first-hand of the pain, anxiety and uncertainty these families, and the whole community, are experiencing. Inspired by the scripture passage of the day, from St. Paul, Bishop Thomas reassured the congregation that they always have a home in the Catholic Church, that in Christ Jesus we find the courage to go forward together and that we "walk by faith, not by sight."

According to Bishop Thomas, "This visit highlighted for me, in a powerful way, the need for all of us to pray and advocate with our elected public officials for a just and fair reform of our Nation's broken immigration system."
