**RELIGIOUS ARTICLES BLESSING:**

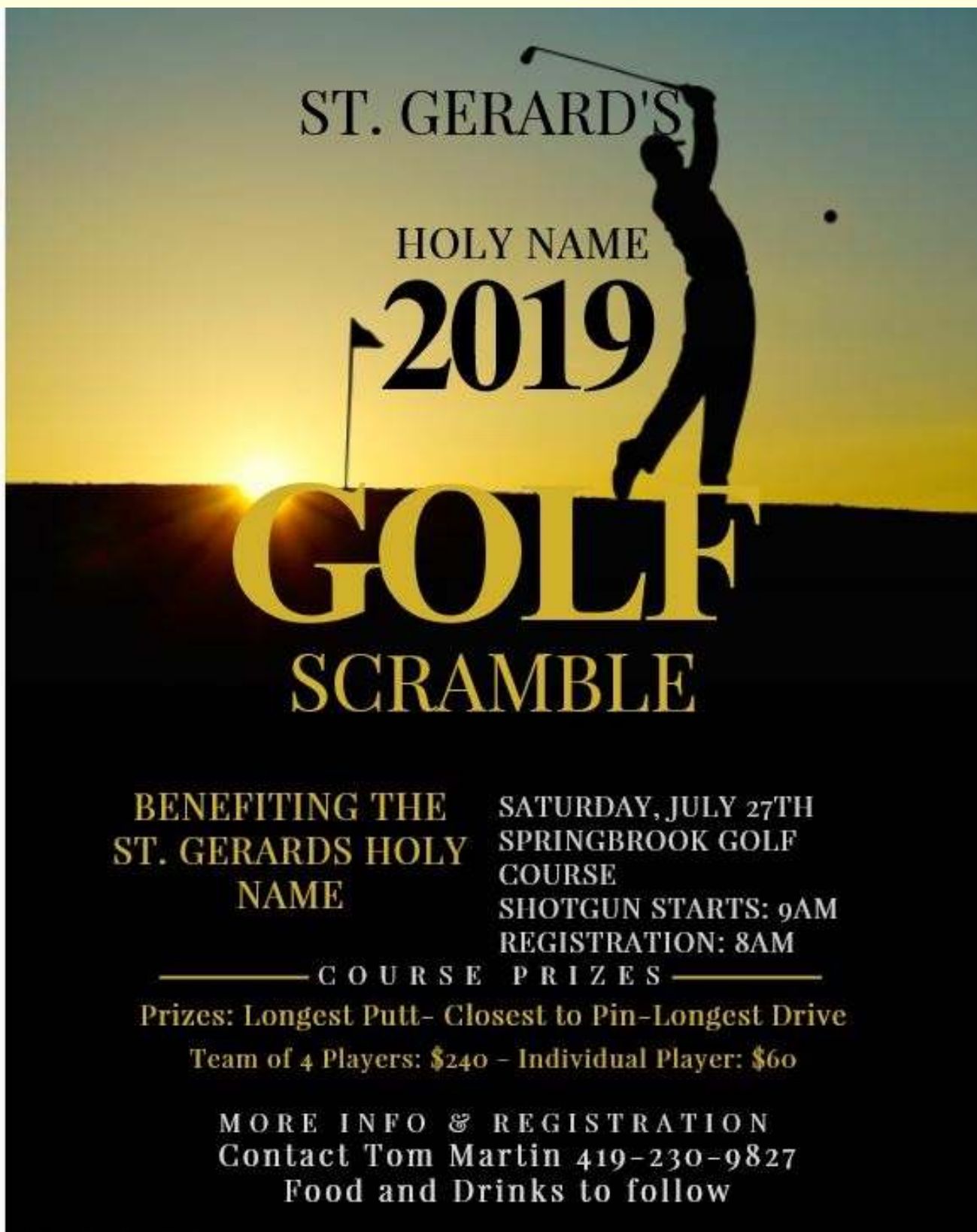
We will be blessing any religious articles next weekend, June 29/30th. Please bring any items (big or small) that you would liked blessed to Mass with you and the priests will bless them.
